


Tools: Phillips screwdriver

5/32" Allen-wrench 3/8" Socket wrench

People Required: 1 Person

Time: 5 Minutes

Backrest Replacement



1. To remove the back with back post, access the underside of the chair, locate and remove the 2 (1/22") Allen-head bolts and washers, and then slide the post with backrest out.

Seat Replacement



1. To remove the seat, access the underside of the chair, locate and remove the 4 (%") Hex-head bolts that secure the seat to the mechanism.


Arm Pad Replacement



1. To remove urethane arm pads, access the underside of the arms, locate and remove the 2 Phillips-head screws secure the pads to the frame.



 Replace backrest and post in reversed order. Always start bolts by hand, being careful not to cross-thread.



2. Replace seat in reversed order. Always start bolts by hand, being careful not to cross-thread.



 Replace pads in reversed order. Always start screws by hand, being careful not to cross-thread.
